

The Game at Summerfield

Purpose:

- To play as a group that is equable for all players that would like to play in the group.

Rules:

- All play will be governed by the United States Golf Association (USGA) and Summerfield club local rules.
- **As of 1/2/09 All will hit only 1 ball from the first tee**
- Tamping down of spike marks and or foot prints is okay without penalty on the putting surface only. The fringe of the green is not the putting surface.
- Each player will pay prior to teeing off \$15.00 to the person running the game for that day.
- There will be 2 ways to win in the pot monies, plus points or skins.
- The 2 pots will be \$10.00 into the points and \$5.00 in skins (a hole-in-one wins the entire skins pot for that day, if there is 2 or more players that have hole-in-one's they will split the total skins pot.)
- Each individual will form their own 4-some.
- To be eligible to play in the game you have to have 2 signed up game players in the playing group.
- To establish a point average the total game points will be divided by the number games played up to the last 10 rounds.
- No player will be paid more than plus 6 points for that day;
- No player pad their point total by posting a point total less than 6 points for that day against their established point average.
- Any new players will have to establish a points average of 5 rounds to be paid the maximum of 6 points.
- The 1st time player will state his handicap and it will determine the number of points they need to accomplish.
- To determine the points of a new individual player they will take their handicap and subtract it from 36 which will determine their points they need to pull for the 1st game played. Example 8 handicap subtracted from 36 means that person has to pull 28 points for their 1st game.
- **Weather / Medical Conditions as of the annual meeting 12/14/08**
 - **If you finish your round and have paid your \$15, then you are in the game, and**
 - **if you did not finish your round due to weather and the course is considered closed for at least one hour, you can get your \$15 refunded, and**
 - **if someone quits his round due to an emergency, he will not be refunded any money but if any skins or points money hold up, then he would still get his cut**

Points

- The game is to be played using the Chicago points system which is approved by the USGA for providing approximate handicaps.
-

- The points follow like this:
 1. Eagle 4 points
 2. Birdie 3 points
 3. Par 2 points
 4. Bogey 1 point

Note: There is no deduction of points for double bogey or worst

Pay Outs

- At the end of each round played by the players in the Summerfield the game the pots will be determined by the number of players for that given day.
- The points pot will be divided by the total number of plus points that are accumulated by all the players. (If none of the players are plus points for the day then the points pot will roll over into the skins pot.
- The skins pot will be divided by the total number of skins. (If there is no skins out for the day then the skins pot will roll over into the points pot)
- If there is no points or skins then the monies will be returned to each player for that days play.
